

THE HALL OF RECORDS

The Akashic Records

The Akashic records (Akasha is a Sanskrit word meaning "sky", "space" or "aether"). It is a theosophical term referring to a universal filing system, or the "Mind of God," which records every occurring thought, word, and action. The records are impressed on a subtle substance called akasha (or somniferous ether).

According to believers, the Akasha is the library of all events and responses concerning consciousness in all realities. Every life form therefore contributes and has access to the Akasha records or the Hall of Records. Any human can become the physical medium for accessing the records, and that various techniques and spiritual disciplines can be employed to achieve the focus state necessary to access the records.

The late American mystic Edgar Cayce, The Sleeping Prophet, referred to the Akashic Records that each person is held to account, (karma), after life and "confronted" with their personal akashic record of what they have or have not done in a karmic sense. The idea is comparable to the biblical Book of Life which is consulted to see whether or not they are admitted into heaven.

Regardless of which reincarnation you've chosen in one's life, the soul constantly experiences the consequences of it's previous choices. This concept is expressed in biblical terminology as "what you sow you must reap" and is generally labeled as "Like attracts like" by students of reincarnation. This essentially means that individuals get to experience for themselves the effects that their previous choices have had upon others.

In terms of personal relationships, we never meet anyone by chance, nor do we ever have an emotional connection (positive or negative) to another individual for the very first time. Relationships are ongoing learning experiential process. In other words we pick our relationships with another person exactly where it had left the last time around. We have experience, some of you, every imaginable relationships from father-daughter, father-son, husband-wife, wife-husband, employer-employee, mother-daughter, mother-son. Interestingly individuals are constantly meeting the memory they have previously built in the relationships with one another and that there really isn't karma between people; instead, there is only karma with one's own self.

In spite of the fact that karma belongs to one's self, each soul is constantly drawn toward certain individuals and groups that will enable them to meet themselves in circumstances and relationships. Those individuals and groups, in turn, are drawn toward specific people in an effort to come to terms with their own karmic memory. By exploring our biographical stories we might discover karma in action. The process of life and death, rebirth, and the movement toward individuality is similar for each of us. Looking at the records and soul histories might enable us to make more educated choices for ourselves as we come to terms with our own karmic memory and the meeting of patterns from the past. The concept of reincarnation explains and clarifies our present life relationships. Often events in the distant past are still influencing current relationships. Becoming aware of the root causes in prior lives can heal the relationships in the present. Awareness and understanding are powerful healing forces.

Our lives are not the result of random actions and events. We choose our parents, who usually are souls with whom we have interacted in prior lifetimes.
